


In Devoran there is plenty of wildlife.

Kingfishers can be spotted at the creek.





Begin here at Devoran Village Hall.

Make a right turn up Market Street. As you stroll up the street, cast a glance at the old village school on your right.

Can you spot the old school bell?

Cross St, Johns Terrace.

Past the church of St John and St Petroc on your left.



Continue your eye-opening walk straight ahead up the farm lane to a stile on your left. Over the stile, follow the path then first right to cross the farmers field.

What animals can you see in the fields?

Carry on straight towards a steep stone stile, over the stile and along the lane.

Take a right at the heavy metal gates that lead you to a calming field. Pass through two more gates, carry on walking along wooded lanes until you go down a steep, long track.

At the bottom, turn right when you get to a narrow road. At the next left you can see Devoran Quay straight ahead.

If your legs are aching then stop of at the Old Quay Inn for a rest and for some relaxing views. Once you are ready to go again, walk along Quay road and then arrive back at Devoran Village Hall.
